EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Overview

The African Reparations Movement (ARM) is proposed as a modern international organisation that combines research, education, technology, governance and community participation to advance reparatory justice. The movement builds upon the legacy of Bernie Grant while looking towards the future.

Our Vision

Our long-term vision is to establish the Bernie Grant Arts Centre as an International Centre for Reparatory Justice. The Centre would provide a permanent home for research, education, policy development, conferences, archives, technology and international collaboration.

The Reparations Infrastructure Platform

We propose developing a Reparations Infrastructure Platform to provide practical support for the global reparations movement. The Platform will evolve to include digital identity, evidence management, research tools, educational resources, collaboration systems and other technologies that assist organisations working towards reparatory justice.

Why a Petition?

The petition is intended to demonstrate public support for relaunching ARM and for the vision of the Bernie Grant Arts Centre becoming its international headquarters. It is the beginning of a movement rather than the end of a campaign.

What Signing Means

Signing the petition expresses support for the objectives described in the petition. It does not create membership, ownership or financial rights. If ARM is formally relaunched, supporters may later be invited to join the organisation through a separate membership process.

Next Steps

Following the petition, the project will continue through organisational development, publication of additional White Papers, international partnerships, technology development and public engagement.
